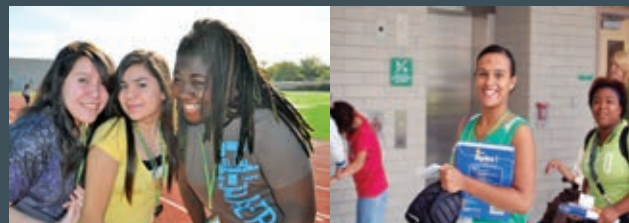

Students who are serious about science can apply to the Northwestern Medicine Scholar's Program at Westinghouse College Prep. This program was created through a partnership with Northwestern Memorial Hospital and the Feinberg School of Medicine. It is exclusive to Westinghouse students who are interested in careers as physicians, biomedical scientists, and researchers.

Students enrolled in the College to Careers program are exposed to curriculum in their chosen career fields as early as freshmen year. Students gain theoretical knowledge from highly trained instructors as well as practical experience through our work-based program in their senior year. Simultaneously, students are required to complete a rigorous college preparatory curriculum that prepares them for any four-year college or university.
